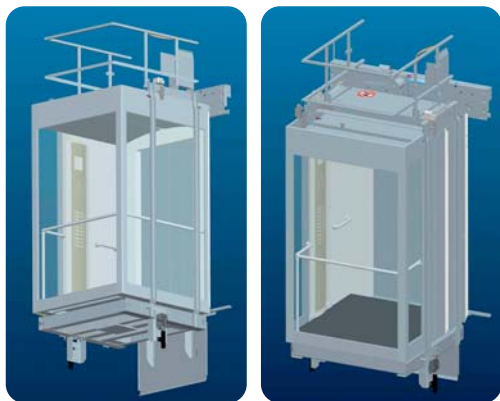

- ⑤ Mirror gold

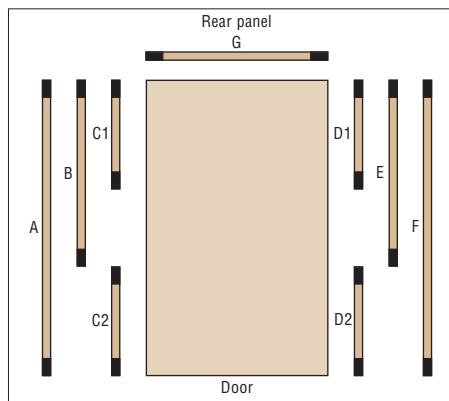
Skinplate
